

#### **Our Theme**

IDEAS Data Visualisation Competition will bring the general theme of Sustainable Development Goals (SDG) by the United Nations, in particular:

- Decent Work and Economic Growth (No. 8)
- Industry, Innovation and Infrastructure (No. 9)

The participants are required to choose either one of the themes, identify a problem within the realization of these goals in Indonesia, and propose a data-driven solution to accelerate the achievement of these goals.

Participants are free to use any reliable data source and any software/tools to visualise the data into relevant figures. IDEAS Data Visualisation

Competition will not provide any data to the participants.

\*\*Final Stage; All 5 groups of finalists required to present their findings and solutions to all of the judges live via Zoom.

### **Participant Criteria**

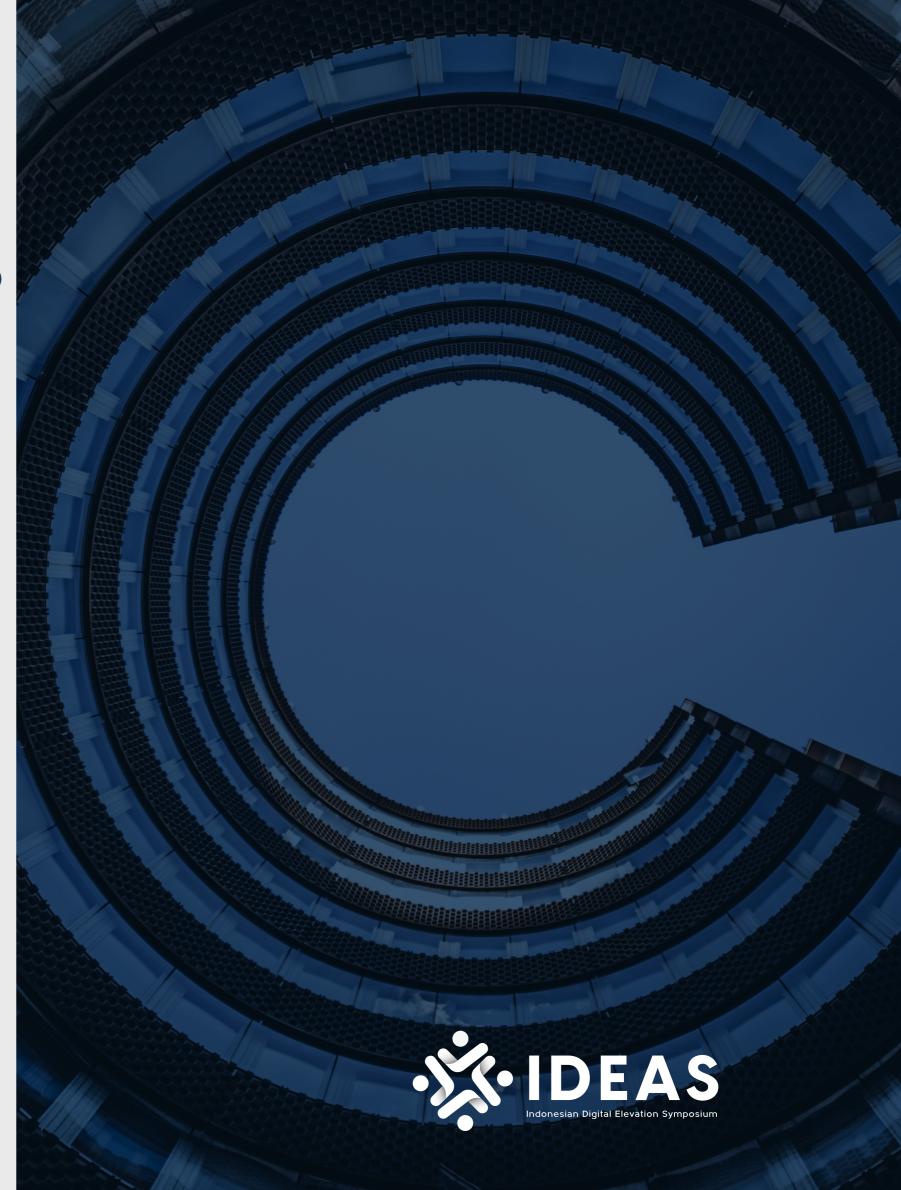
To join this competition, participants need to fulfill these following criterias:
